CITY OF ADRIAN PROPOSAL

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO SECTION 5.6 OF THE ADRIAN CITY CHARTER-FILLING OF VACANCIES IN ELECTIVE OFFICES

It is proposed that upon the occurrence of a vacancy in the office of mayor or city commissioner, and for any current vacancy in those offices, that the city commission shall either: 1) call a special election to fill the vacancy for the balance of the unexpired term, or 2) appoint an eligible person to hold the position until the next regular city election (at which election the position shall be filled for the balance, if any, of the unexpired term). Shall the proposed amendment be adopted?

CAMBRIDGE TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL

Public Safety Millage Renewal

Shall the expired previous voted increases in the tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Cambridge Township, of 1.2500 mils (\$1.25 per \$1,000 of taxable value), be renewed at 1.2500 mils (\$1.25 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for four (4) years from 2020 through 2023 inclusive, for the operation and maintenance of the Cambridge Township Fire Department and the Cambridge Township Police Department, raising an estimated \$466,900 in the first year the millage is levied, of which a portion will be disbursed to the Onsted Downtown Development Authority?

Building and Apparatus Replacement Millage-Fire and Police

Shall Cambridge Township impose an increase of up to .25 mils (\$.25 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for 4 (four) years, 2020 through 2023 inclusive, for building and apparatus replacement needs in the Cambridge Township Fire Department and the Cambridge Township Police Department, which mils increase will raise an estimated \$93,400 in the first year the millage is levied, which levy shall be allocated at the discretion of the township board, and of which a portion will be disbursed to the Onsted Downtown Development Authority?

Additional Operation and Maintenance Millage-Fire and Police Departments

Shall Cambridge Township impose a increase of up to .25 mils (\$.25 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for 4 (four) years, 2020 through 2023 inclusive, for operation and maintenance needs in the Cambridge Township Fire Department and the Cambridge Township Police Department, which mils increase will raise an estimated \$93,400 in the first year the millage is levied, which levy shall be allocated to provide fire and police protection for the residents of the township, at the discretion of the township board, and of which a portion will be disbursed to the Onsted Downtown Development Authority?

CLINTON TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL

Clinton Township Road/Street Millage Renewal

Shall the Township of Clinton, Lenawee County Michigan, for the purpose of road and street repairs and maintenance of roads and streets establish and authorize a renewed millage levy not to exceed 1.000 mills (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for 8 years, 2021 through 2029. This renewed tax should raise approximately \$117,517.00 total revenue with an estimated \$59,933.00 to the village and an estimated \$57,583.00 to the township.

Township of Clinton
Library Millage Proposal

This proposal restores library millage previously approved by the voters that has been lost as a result of the reduction required by the "Headlee" amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all taxable property in the Township of Clinton, Lenawee County, Michigan, be increased by and the Township be authorized to levy 0.1661 mill (\$0.1661 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 20 years, 2020 to 2039, inclusive, for the purpose of maintaining a Township library; the estimate of the revenue the Township will collect and disburse to the Clinton Township Public Library if the millage is approved and levied in 2020 is approximately \$19,788 (this millage is to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the "Headlee" amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963)?

DEERFIELD TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL

FIRE OPERATIONS RENEWAL PROPOSAL

Shall Deerfield Township, County of Lenawee, State of Michigan, be authorized to levy annually an amount not to exceed .25 mill (\$.25 on each \$1,000 of taxable value), which is a renewal of the previously authorized millage rate that expired in 2019, against all taxable property within the Township for a period of two (2) years, 2020 to 2021, inclusive, for the purpose of purchasing for and operating the fire department and any other purpose authorized by law for fire department or fire service purposes? The estimate of the revenue the Township will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Township in the first year (2020) is approximately \$19,000.

FIRE EQUIPMENT RENEWAL PROPOSAL

Shall Deerfield Township, County of Lenawee, State of Michigan, be authorized to levy annually an amount not to exceed .50 mill (\$.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable value), which is a renewal of the previously authorized millage rate that expired in 2019, against all taxable property within the Township for a period of two (2) years, 2020 to 2021 inclusive, for the purpose of maintaining and purchasing equipment for the fire department? The estimate of the revenue the Township will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Township in the first year (2020) is approximately \$38,000.

ROAD MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

Shall Deerfield Township, County of Lenawee, State of Michigan, be authorized to levy annually an amount not to exceed 3.0 mills (\$3.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable value), which is a renewal of the previously authorized millage rate that expired in 2019, against all taxable property within the Township for a period of two (2) years, 2020 to 2021, inclusive, for the purpose of constructing, preserving, improving, repairing, and maintaining roads and bridges in the Township? The estimate of the revenue the Township will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Township in the first year (2020) is approximately \$230,000.

FAIRFIELD TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL

FIRE AND RESCUE RENEWAL

Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation on General Ad Valorem Taxes imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution, in Fairfield Township of 1.4828 mills be renewed (\$1.4828 per \$1000 of taxable value) for a period of 4 years, 2021 through 2024 inclusive for the Fire and Rescue operations, and shall the Township levy such millage upon taxable real and personal property within the Township for said purpose thereby raising in the first year and estimated \$89,875?

ROAD AND BRIDGE RENEWAL

Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation on General Ad Valorem Taxes imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution, in Fairfield Township of 1.9772 mills be renewed (\$1.9772 per \$1000 of taxable value) for a period of 4 years, 2021 through 2024 inclusive for the Road and Bridge maintenance and improvement within the Township, and shall the Township levy such millage upon taxable real and personal property within the Township for said purpose thereby raising in the first year and estimated \$119,841?

PROPOSITION TO AUTHORIZE RENEWAL
OF AN ADDITIONAL TAX OF 1.5 MILL
TO PROVIDE FOR ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND
IMPROVEMENT WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF MACON

Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation on General Ad Valorem Taxes imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution, in Macon Township of 1.5000 mills be restored by a renewal at 1.4884 mills (\$1.4884 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and an increase of .0116 mills (\$.0116 per \$1,000 of taxable value), to bring it to the original 1.5000 mills, for the period of 4 years, 2021 through 2024 inclusive, for the purpose of road maintenance and improvement within said Township, and shall the Township levy such millage upon taxable real and personal property within the Township for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$104,247.

PROPOSITION TO AUTHORIZE

Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation on General Ad Valorem Taxes imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution, in Macon Township of .5000 mills be restored by a renewal of .4961 mills (\$.4961 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and an increase of .0039 (\$.0039 per \$1,000 of taxable value), to bring it to the original .5000 mills, for the period of 4 years, 2021 through 2024, inclusive, for the purpose of fire protection within said Township, and shall the Township levy such millage upon taxable real and personal property within the Township for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$34,749.

Shall the 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) authorization set by separate tax limitation in 1968 for Macon Township under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution, and reduced to .9978 mills (\$.9978 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be restored to the original authorized rate by an increase of .0022 mills (\$.0022 per \$1,000 of taxable value), thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$69,498.

Shall the previous voted millage in the Charter Township of Madison of 0.9661 mills (\$0.9661 per \$1,000 of taxable value) be renewed at 0.9661 mills (\$0.9661 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for 4 years, 2021 through 2024 inclusive, for the purpose of replacing fire and ambulance equipment and housing of same. Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation on General Ad Valorem Taxes within Medina Township imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution, be restored by a renewal of 1.9836 mill (\$1.9836 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of 4 years, 2020 through 2024 inclusive for the purpose of road and bridge maintenance and improvement within said Township, and shall the Township levy such millage upon taxable real and personalproperty within the Township for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$102,075?

Shall Ogden Township, County of Lenawee, State of Michigan, be authorized to levy annually an amount not to exceed 0.75 mill (\$0.75 on each \$1,000 of taxable value), which is a renewal of the previously authorized millage that expired in 2019, against all taxable property within the Township for a period of four (4) years, 2020 to 2023, inclusive, for the purpose of operating, equipping, purchasing and contracting for fire and ambulance services? The estimate of the revenue the Township will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Township in the first year (2020) is approximately \$62,361. By contract, revenue from this millage will be distributed to Madison Charter Township.

ROAD MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

Shall Ogden Township, County of Lenawee, State of Michigan, be authorized to levy annually an amount not to exceed 2.0 mills (\$2.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable value), which is a renewal of the previously authorized millage that expired in 2019, against all taxable property within the Township for a period of four (4) years, 2020 to 2023, inclusive, for the purpose of improving, repairing, and maintaining roads and bridges in the Township? The estimate of the revenue the Township will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Township in the first year (2020) is approximately \$166,295.

RIDGEWAY TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL

Proposition 1 Road Millage Renewal

The remaining .6095 mill is only available to be levied to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the "Headlee" amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and will only be levied to the extent necessary to restore that reduction.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Addison Community Schools, Lenawee, Hillsdale and Jackson Counties, Michigan, be renewed by 18.6095 mills (\$18.6095 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2021 to 2025, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2021 is approximately \$3,390,210 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2020 tax levy)?

The remaining .8418 mill is only available to be levied to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the "Headlee" amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and will only be levied to the extent necessary to restore that reduction.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Hudson Area Schools, Lenawee and Hillsdale Counties, Michigan, be renewed by 18.8418 mills (\$18.8418 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 6 years, 2021 to 2026, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2021 is approximately \$943,035 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2020 tax levy)?

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Morenci Area Schools, Lenawee County, Michigan, be increased by 18 mills (\$18.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for the year 2020, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2020 is approximately \$701,880 (this is a renewal of millage that expired with the 2019 tax levy)?
