

## **Special May 4, 2021 Election Information**

\*The following schools and township will be holding a Special May Election.  
The proposals listed will be on the ballot\*

### **Clinton Community Schools-**

CLINTON COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

#### **BONDING PROPOSAL**

Shall Clinton Community Schools, Lenawee and Washtenaw Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Thirty-Four Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$34,800,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of:

erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to school buildings;  
remodeling, equipping and re-equipping and furnishing and refurbishing  
school buildings; acquiring, installing, equipping and re-equipping school  
buildings for instructional technology; purchasing school buses; and  
preparing, developing and improving sites?

The following is for informational purposes only:

The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2021 is 0 mill (\$0.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is twenty-five (25) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 5.66 mills (\$5.66 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).

The school district does not expect to borrow from the State to pay debt service on the bonds. The total amount of qualified bonds currently outstanding is \$965,000. The total amount of qualified loans currently outstanding is \$-0-. The estimated computed millage rate may change based on changes in certain circumstances.

(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)

## **Madison School District-**

### MADISON SCHOOL DISTRICT OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2021 tax levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 19 mills (\$19.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Madison School District, Lenawee County, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 5 years, 2022 to 2026, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2022 is approximately \$2,001,631 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2021 tax levy)?

### MADISON SCHOOL DISTRICT SINKING FUND MILLAGE PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy building and site sinking fund millage previously approved by the electors.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Madison School District, Lenawee County, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed 1.5 mills (\$1.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2021 to 2025, inclusive, to continue to provide for a sinking fund for the purchase of real estate for sites for, and the construction or repair of, school buildings and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2021 is approximately \$270,225?

## **Morenci Area Schools-**

MORENCI AREA SCHOOLS

### OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Morenci Area Schools, Lenawee County, Michigan, be increased by 18 mills (\$18.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for the year 2021, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district

will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2021 is approximately \$763,828 (this is a renewal of millage that expired with the 2020 tax levy)?

### **Tecumseh Public Schools-**

TECUMSEH PUBLIC SCHOOLS  
MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL TO PROVIDE FUNDS  
TO OPERATE A SYSTEM OF PUBLIC RECREATION AND PLAYGROUNDS

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy public recreation millage previously approved by the electors that will expire with the 2021 levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of .2488 mill (\$0.2488 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Tecumseh Public Schools, Lenawee County, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 5 years, 2022 to 2026, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for operating a system of public recreation and playgrounds; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect for such recreation program if the millage is approved and levied in 2022 is approximately \$162,000 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2021 tax levy)?

### **Riga Township-**

**Local Proposal No. 1**

A proposed initiated ordinance in the Township of Riga to provide for the regulation and number of recreational (adult-use) marijuana establishments under the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marijuana Act, Initiated Law 1 of 2018. The ordinance would:

- authorize within the Township up to five class B marijuana growers operating indoors on parcels of at least fifteen (15) acres;
- limit the Township's application fee to no more than \$100 for an initial Provisional License and no more than \$4,900 for the final application fee;
- prohibit the Township's Clerk from refusing to process an application for any reason other than failure to pay the initial application fee;
- provide a scoring procedure for the Township Clerk based on completeness of the application, business experience of the applicant, and security features for the proposed establishment set forth in the application with a tie breaker process; and

- prohibiting the Township from interfering with the transfer of licenses issued under the Ordinance to a different individual or entity.

**Monroe County Intermediate School District-  
(only voters who reside in Riga Township and Whiteford Agricultural Schools)**

Monroe County Intermediate School District  
Regional Enhancement Millage Renewal Proposal

This proposal will allow the intermediate school district to continue to levy regional enhancement millage that will expire with the 2021 levy. Pursuant to state law, the revenue raised by the proposed millage will be collected by the intermediate school district and distributed to the constituent districts of the intermediate school district based on pupil membership count.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Monroe County Intermediate School District, Michigan, be renewed by .9866 mill (\$0.9866 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2022 to 2026, inclusive, to provide operating funds to enhance other state and local funding for constituent district technology purposes and related expenses; the estimate of the revenue the intermediate school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2022 is approximately \$6,151,499, which funds are expected to be disbursed as required by statute to Airport Community Schools, Bedford Public Schools, Dundee Community Schools, Ida Public Schools, Jefferson Schools, Mason Consolidated Schools, Monroe Public Schools, Summerfield Schools, Whiteford Agricultural School District, New Bedford Academy, Triumph Academy and Monroe County Intermediate School District (this is a renewal of millage which will expire with the 2021 levy)?
