**LENAWEE DISTRICT LIBRARY VOTERS- LIBRARY MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL**

Shall the Lenawee District Library, County of Lenawee, be authorized to levy a renewal of the previously voted increase in the tax limitation, which expired in 2022, in an amount not to exceed .5998 mill (\$0.5998 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) annually against all taxable property within the Lenawee District Library district for a period of ten (10) years, 2023 to 2032, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the District Library will collect in the first year of levy (2023) if the millage is approved and levied by the District Library is approximately \$1,283,000.

**WOODSTOCK TOWNSHIP VOTERS- RENEWAL OF FIRE MILLAGE**

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in the Township of Woodstock of 0.75 mills (\$0.750 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) be renewed up to 0.75 mills (\$0.750 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) and levied for 3 years 2024 through 2026 inclusive for the purpose of providing additional revenue for fire protection and prevention, which increase will raise an estimated \$169,560.66 in the first year the millage is levied?
